

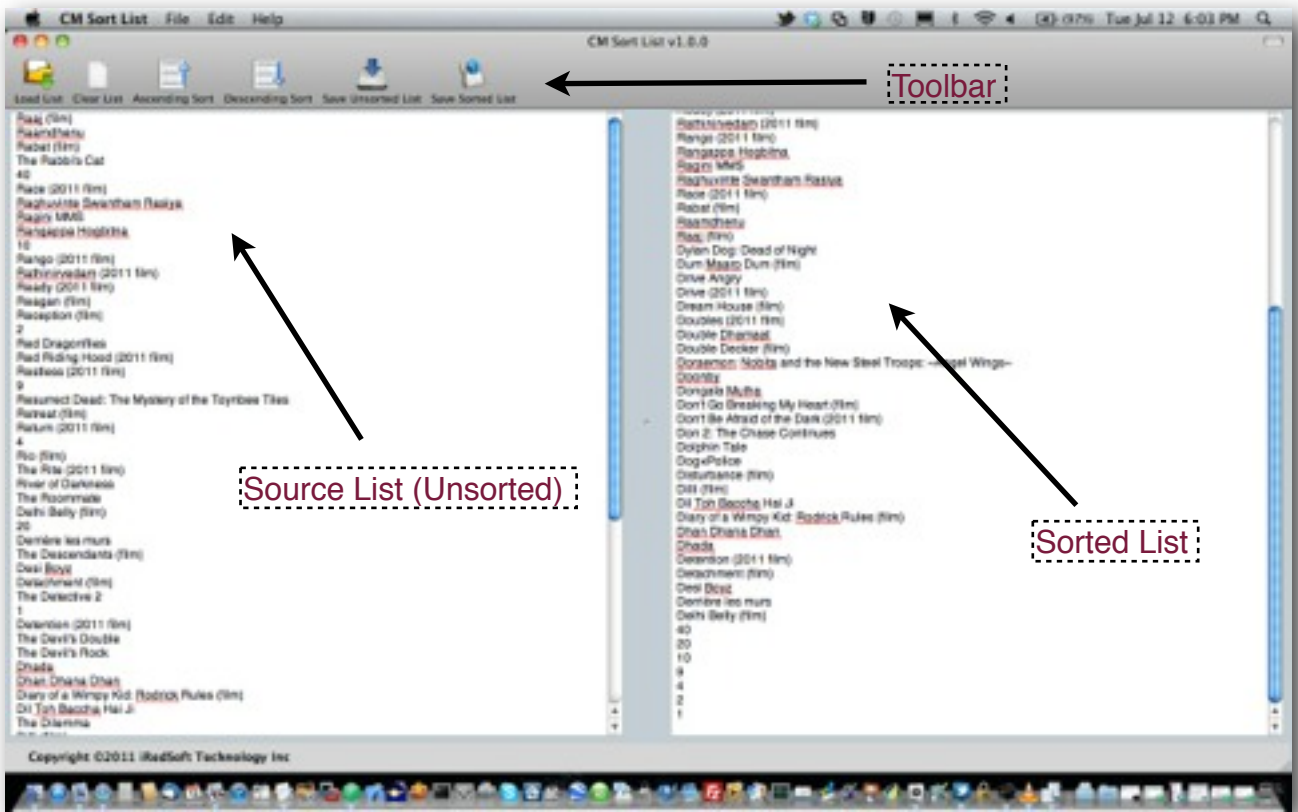

# Windows



There are 3 main core sections in CM Sort List.

The left panel is the Source List where you can drag and drop or copy and paste list to sort. The right panel is the Sorted List which would contain the list after it is sorted either ascending or descending order.

The Toolbar is where you do Load, Save and Sort the List.

# Toolbar



## Load List

This allows you to load the list to be sorted. This can be a Plain Text (txt) or Rich Text File (rtf). This will load the list into the Source List pane.

## Clear List

This will clear both the Source List and Sorted List.

## Ascending Sort

This will sort the source list in the Ascending Order and populate the Sorted List pane with the results.

## Descending Sort

This will sort the source list in the Descending Order and populate the Sorted List pane with the results.

## Save Unsorted List

This will allow you to save the Source List as a text file.

## Save Sorted List

This will allow you to save the Sorted List as a text file.

# How To

- 1) To begin using CM Sort List, you would need to load the Text File using the “Load List” button on the menu bar and selecting a text file with the .TXT or .RTF file extension. As CM Sort List does not support Pages or Word file format, you would need to open the documents in the respective application and do a Copy and Paste the list to CM Sort List on the Left Panel. Alternatively, you can select the list and just drag them into CM Sort List on the Left Panel.
- 2) Once the list is loaded on the Left Panel, click either the “Ascending Sort” or “Descending Sort” depending on which order you want to sort the list. The Sorted List would be shown on the Right Panel. At this stage, you could do a “Save Sorted List” to save the Sorted List on the Right Panel into a file. Alternatively, you can select the entire list and Copy and Paste to where you want to use the list or you could just select the list and drag them into the app you want to use it for.

## Notes

**If the list only shows up as one item on the right hand panel, it would mean that CM Sort List cannot locate any carriage return or line break on each line. What you would need to do is to hit the “Return” or “Enter” key at the end of each line and when done, you can do the Sort again.**
