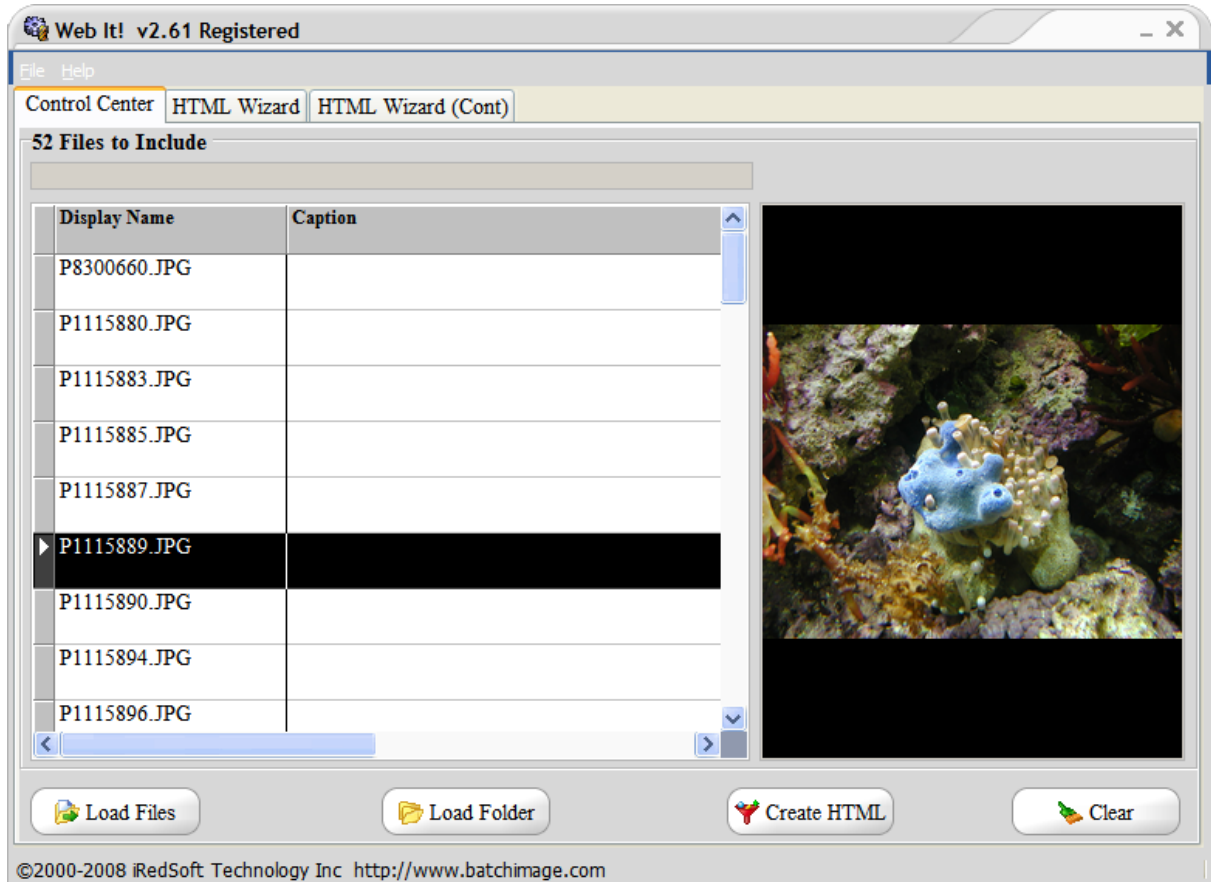

Introduction



Web It! is a HTML Image Thumbnail Galleries Creator. Now you do not need to know HTML or spend a considerable time creating thumbnail galleries and linking them to the image files. Let Web It! do the mundane task for you.

Web It! would create thumbnails from the source images, generate the thumbnail galleries and create the links or html frame pages for each of your images. It can also create HTML based Slideshow for you.

Web It! makes it simple for you to share your images with your family, friends and anyone else across the internet. All you would need to do is to use Web It! to generate the thumbnail galleries and upload all your files to your website.

There are a number of free-hosting websites which allow you to host your images but require you to create html pages hosting their banners on every images. With Web It!, this can be created with ease. All you need to do is to paste the required HTML codes into Web It! and it will insert them on all your image pages.

Web It! is great for anyone who takes pictures and want to share them. Because it uses HTML, the galleries can be viewed by any web browsers. If you want to put the thumbnail galleries on CD-ROM or a HTML enabled Kiosks, no problem. Since a majority of computers already has a web browser

installed, just launching the index page in the browser would allow you to start the thumbnail galleries.

What are you waiting for ? You can use Web It! to create photo galleries for your holiday pictures, product ranges, family pictures or basically any images. Works great for the home,

Features

Web It! allows you to create HTML based thumbnail image galleries, file listings and html slideshows through its comprehensive and yet simple-to-use interface.

With Web It!, you do not need to know HTML or web designing. All it takes is just a few mouse clicks and you are on your way to create professional looking galleries. The program uses standard HTML codes so you could easily edit the codes in any html editor.

The Control Panel allows you to load image list, preview the images and change display name and add captions to each individual images. this allow you to provide a more comprehensive description of the images. This is particularly useful when you are sharing new places or events with your family, friends, colleagues or clients.

Web It! is simple to use. Just load up your images, make a few settings, click Create Thumbnails then sit back and relax. In no time, you will have beautifully created thumbnail galleries for you to show your friends on the web or burn them on CDs.

****New in v2.58**** Web It! supports creation of non-image HTML based galleries and file listing.

****New in v2.59**** Web It! supports non-web supported images. The typical image formats supported on web browsers natively are JPG, GIF and PNG. When the web browser encounters a non-support image format, it may either require you to download and install a plug-in or does not show up the file. With v2.59, Web It! will create JPEG thumbnails and at the same time provide download links to those non-supported images.

7 Quick Start Guide

7.1 Create Thumbnail Galleries

Creating Thumbnail Galleries

This is a simple step-by-step guide to creating a thumbnail galleries. It does not however describe all the various controls and settings.

Steps

1. On the Control Center, use Load Folder to select the directories to load the images from. The filenames would be loaded to the Filename list on the left panel.
2. On the HTML Wizard page, change the Design Type to Table Listing
3. Change Hyperlink to HTML Still (This would create a html page for each image file)
4. Under Background, Text, Visited Link, Active Link and Link Color set it to the desirable color. Make sure the background, text and link color are not the same. If they are, it would appear as invisible.
5. Under Items per page, enter the total number of thumbnails you want it to include on each page. If the number of images exceed that number, additional thumbnail gallery page would be created.

Under Thumbnails per row, enter the number of thumbnails on each thumbnail row.
6. Click Save In to determine the directory to save the thumbnail galleries and associated files in. It is preferable to use a different directory from the source directory.
7. Check Preview in Default Web Browser after HTML Generation. This will open the first thumbnail gallery page in your defaulted web browser once it complete its process.
8. Return to Control Center and click Create HTML and wait.
9. Once the Thumbnail galleries are created, it will be displayed in your web browser.

7.2 Create Non Image based Thumbnail Galleries

Creating Non Image Based Thumbnail Galleries

This is a simple step-by-step guide to creating a non-image thumbnail galleries. It does not however describe all the various controls and settings.

Steps

1. On the Control Center, use Load Folder to select the directories to load the images from. The filenames would be loaded to the Filename list on the left panel. Or using the Load Files, you can selective opt for which images to be included. Change the **File of Type** to **All Files**.

*By default, images files would be shown

2. On the HTML Wizard page, change the Design Type to Table Listing or File Directory
3. Change Hyperlink to Resources (This would create a html page for each image file)
4. Under Background, Text, Visited Link, Active Link and Link Color set it to the desirable color. Make sure the background, text and link color are not the same. If they are, it would appear as invisible.
5. Under Items per page, enter the total number of thumbnails you want it to include on each page. If the number of images exceed that number, additional thumbnail gallery page would be created.

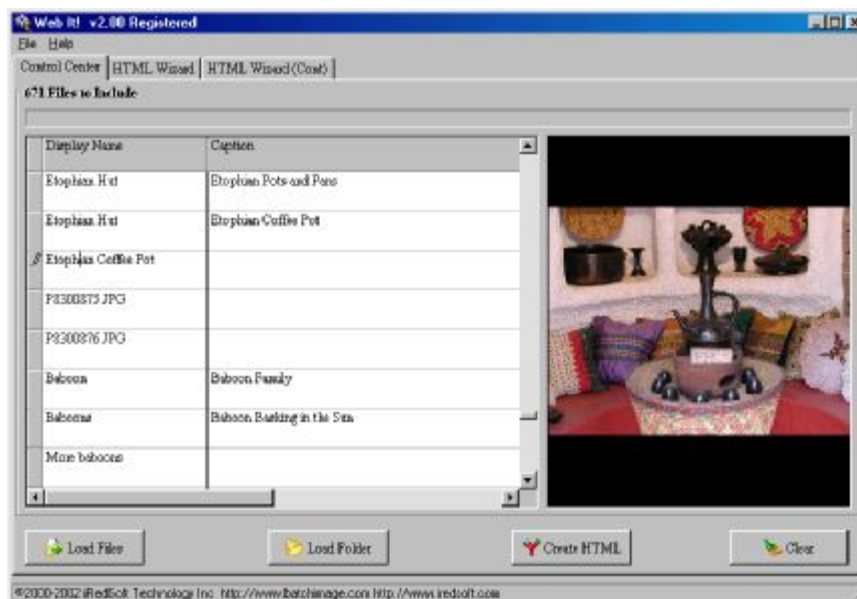
Under Thumbnails per row, enter the number of thumbnails on each thumbnail row.

6. Click Save In to determine the directory to save the thumbnail galleries and associated files in. It is preferable to use a different directory from the source directory.
7. Check Preview in Default Web Browser after HTML Generation. This will open the first thumbnail gallery page in your defaulted web browser once it complete its process.
8. Return to Control Center and click Create HTML and wait.
9. Once the Thumbnail galleries are created, it will be displayed in your web browser.

8 Program Interface Description

8.1 Control Center

Control Center



The Control Center is the main screen where you would do the most work in. It allows you to load, sort, add captions and create the html galleries.

Panels

There are two panels on the control center. The left is the filename listing and the right is the image preview. The filename listing would allow you to change the Display name of each image and add text caption for each image. The Display Name is the name which is displayed on the thumbnail galleries. The Caption would appear under each image if you set the Hyperlink to as HTML Still or Slideshow.

By clicking on the display name (row), the image would be loaded in the Image Preview panel. This allows easy association with the display name and caption when creating the thumbnail gallery.

In the Filename Listing, if you can alternate scroll between the Caption and the Original Filename by scrolling left to right.

Web It! allows you to save the File listing with its new display name and captions for future use or to export them to XML, HTML or CSV format. This can be activated by clicking the right-most mouse button when at the filename listing. This would bring up a popup menu.



Web It! allows you includes a **Thumbnail Gallery** which allows you to preview all the images on your

list. This allows you to move, delete and rotate the images.

Save/Load File List would save or load the listing to and from the web it file format. Using **Export List** would allow you to save the existing list in **HTML, XML or CSV** format. The CSV format allows you to import into program such as Microsoft Excel.

Image Preview

Using the Popup Menu by pointing on the Image and clicking the right-most mouse button would reveal a menu of functions.

To **rotate** the images 90° Left or Right, use the popup menu and select the necessary option. To revert to the original state, click on **Undo**. If you are satisfied, you could opt to **SAVE** it which would overwrite the original image file.

Control Buttons

There are 4 buttons in Control Center. **Load Files** would allow you to load image files selectively into the filename list. **Load Folder** allows you to import an entire file folder. **Clear** would empty the existing list.

Create HTML would begin the HTML creation process. This can take a couple of minutes to complete depending on the image file size and the number of items on the list. You will be able to track the progress through the progress bar at the top. To terminate the process, click **ESC**.

Main Menu Functions

Files

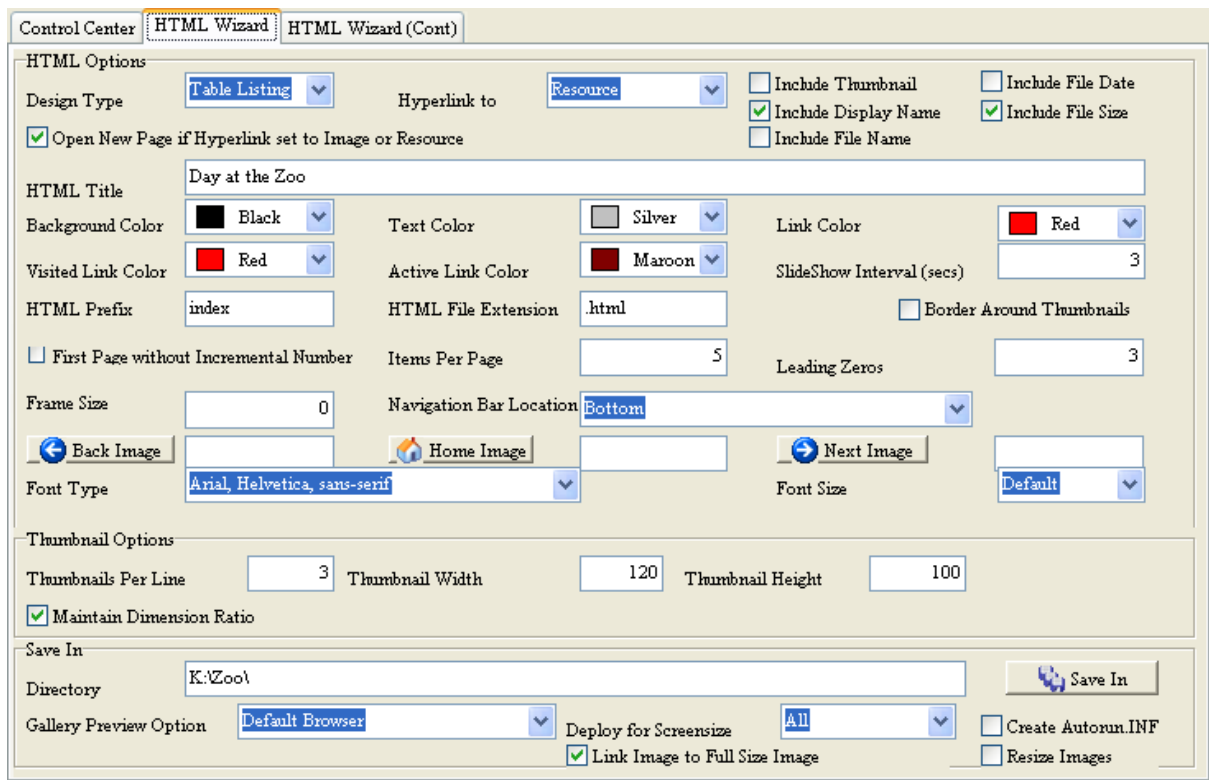
Load and Save Profiles allows you to load and save the settings to and from the profile file. Generally, when you quit from the program, it will take a snapshot of all the settings in the program which would be use during the next start-up. However, there may be situations when you want to define different settings for different jobs.

Help

Batchimage.com News allows you to access our news bulletin board from within the program. This would include news about our products updates, new products and so on. You will need to be connected to the website to access this.

8.2 HTML Wizard

HTML Wizard



This main HTML Wizard page allows you to define the settings in creating the html pages. The settings may seem intimidating but we will attempt to describe each setting.

The HTML Wizard is made up of 3 main panels, HTML Options, Thumbnail Options and Save In options.

HTML Options

Design Type

There are two available options here, Table Listing and File Directory.

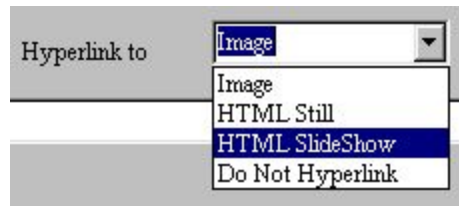


The Table Listing would allow you to create thumbnail galleries using tables.

The File Directory would create file directory style galleries with one image per line.

Hyperlink To

There are four available options.



Setting it to Image would create a hyperlink from the thumbnail gallery to the image file directly.

Setting it to HTML Still would create a HTML page for each image.

Setting it to HTML Slideshow would create a HTML page for each image and set meta refresh mode. This would allow the web browser to advance to a new page after a determined interval.

Setting it to Do Not Hyperlink would create the Thumbnail Galleries without any link to the images.

If you set linking to non-images, set the Hyperlink to Resource.

- Include Thumbnail** Checking this option would include a thumbnail for each image into the thumbnail gallery page.
- Include Display Name** Checking this option would include the Display Name defined in the Control Center for each image in the thumbnail gallery page.
- Include File Name** Checking this option would include the Image File name.
- Include File Date** Checking this option would include the creation date of the image file into the thumbnail gallery page for each image.
- Include File Size** Checking this option would include the file size in kilobytes for each image into the thumbnail gallery page.
- Open New Pages if Hyperlink Set To Image or Resource** This will add 'target=_blank' to the links to the images or resources in the thumbnail gallery page if the Hyperlink is set to Image or Resource
- HTML Title** This set the HTML Title for the thumbnail gallery. This will displayed on the top of the web browser title window.
- Note : If you are including your own header tags such as CSS Stylesheet tags and so on. You could leave the HTML Title blank and include <title> </title> within Additional Header Tag.
- Background Color** This would set the background color for the thumbnail gallery and associated page.
- This define the <Body BgColor= > option.
- Visited Link Color** The Visited Link Color is the color of the link which has been visited earlier by the browser.
- This defines the <Body vlink= > option.

Active Link Color	<p>The Active Link Color is the color of the link when the mouse button is being clicked.</p> <p>This defines the <Body alink= > option.</p>
Link Color	<p>The Link Color is the color of the link which has not been clicked before.</p> <p>This defines the <Body link= > option.</p>
HTML Prefix	<p>This defines the filename of the thumbnail gallery html pages. This will be appended with the thumbnail gallery page number.</p> <p>For example, index would create thumbnail gallery html pages like index1.html , index2.html and so on.</p>
HTML File Extension	<p>Beginning from v2.55, you can change the file extension to be consistent with what your web site is using. All generated files are still based in the HTML Format.</p>
First Page Without Incremental Number	<p>By Default, the first thumbnail index page would be named using the 'HTML Prefix'+Running Number+HTML File Extension, ie index1.html.</p> <p>However, there may be instances in which you require the index page to be named index.html. Check this option and the first page will not include the Running Number.</p>
SlideShow Interval	<p>This defines the number of seconds before refreshing to the next image page if HTML Slideshow option is selected.</p>
Border Around Thumbnails	<p>This determines the border thickness size around each thumbnail. Set it to 0 if you do not want a border.</p> <p>This defines option.</p>
Frame Size	<p>This determines the border thickness around the entire thumbnail gallery table. Set it to 0 if you do not want a border.</p> <p>This defines <table border= > option.</p>
Navigation Bar Location	<p>Traditionally, the Navigation Bar is placed right below the images but beginning with v2.55, you can set it to appear on the Top, Bottom or both Top and Bottom.</p>
Items Per Page	<p>This defines the total number of Thumbnails to appear on each page.</p> <p>This determines the total number of <td> Table Data item on each gallery page.</p>
Leading Zeros	<p>This defines the number of number padding when appending the thumbnail gallery index page number to the thumbnail gallery html pages.</p>
Back Image	<p>This is the Back Button image to be used. If this is empty, the text</p>

'BACK' would be substituted.

On the Thumbnail Gallery Pages, this would bring it to the prior gallery page. This would not appear on the first page.

On the HTML Image pages, this would bring it to the prior image page. This would not appear on the first page.

Home Image

This is the Home button image to be used. If this is empty, the text 'HOME' would be used instead.

On the Subsequent Thumbnail Gallery pages, the home would bring it back to the main Gallery page. On Image HTML pages, this would bring you back to the thumbnail gallery page which its thumbnail is found in.

Next Image

This is the Next Button image to be used. If this is empty, the text 'NEXT' would be substituted.

On the Thumbnail Gallery Pages, this would bring it to the next gallery page. This would not appear on the last page.

On the HTML Image pages, this would bring it to the next image page. This would not appear on the last page.

Font Type

This allow you to use the preset font set for the thumbnail galleries.

This defines option

Font Size

Web It! supports both absolute font size and relative font size. For Absolute font size, the ranges are 1 to 7 and the Relative font size ranges from -7 to +7.

This defines option.

Thumbnails Options**Thumbnails Per Line**

This determines how many thumbnails would appear on each row.

This defines the number of <td> Table Data within each <tr> Table Row.

Thumbnail Width

This defines the thumbnail width in terms of pixels.

Thumbnail Height

This defines the thumbnail height in terms of pixels.

Maintain Dimension Ratio

By checking this option, the thumbnail would maintain as closely the dimension ratio defined by either thumbnail width or height.

If this is uncheck, the thumbnail would take the size as defined by thumbnail width and height without taking into account the dimension ratio. Ensure the dimension for width and height is greater than 0 if using this option.

Save in Options

Directory This defines the directory in which the thumbnail galleries files would be saved in.

Gallery Preview Option Select an option if you want to view the HTML Gallery after it has been created. The available options are :-

None - Do Nothing After the HTML Gallery are created

Default Browser - Launches the Default Browser after the HTML Gallery are created

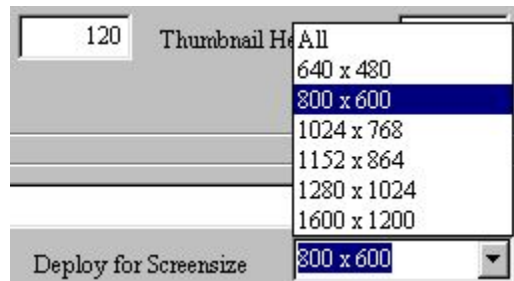
Encapsulated Internet Explorer - Launches Internet Explorer ActiveX within the program

Internal Web Browser - Launches the Internal HTML Viewer.

Note : If Internet Explorer is not installed, the Encapsulated Internet Explorer option would not work.

The Internal Web Browser is a limited html viewer and does not support 'TARGET' or scripting. This works with basic HTML codes.

Deploy for screensize This is useful if the images you want to display is larger than the screen size of the users who would be viewing them. The Images would only be resized if the Resize Original option is checked. Otherwise, the image would be tagged with the downsized Width and Height.



By web deployment, a default 800 x 600 is most acceptable.

Create autorun.INF The Autorun.inf file is the autorun file used in Autorun CD-ROM. This file determines the start file.

By selecting this option, the autorun.inf file is created in the directory of the thumbnail gallery. To create an autorun CD-ROM, you will need a CD-Writer or DVD-writer and a CD-ROM creation software like Roxio Easy CD Creator or Nero. Just copy all the thumbnail gallery files including the autorun.inf file to the CD-ROM and it will autorun when it is inserted onto a Windows-based Computer.

The Autorun would not work under Mac or the Linux environment. However the thumbnail galleries would still work under those platform.

Resize Original By checking this option, it will resize the images to fit the Deployed Screen Size option. By doing this, it will reduce the file size thus saving download bandwidth when your album is being viewed.

8.3 HTML Wizard (Con't)

HTML Wizard (Con't)

This is the Advanced Setting Page which allows you to add other Header tags, HTML above and below the thumbnail galleries.

The **Additional Header Tag** allows you to add other meta tags such as Author info, Page Expiry Date and Cascading Stylesheet tags. The discussion is beyond the scope of the program. However, if you are interested in knowing more, feel free to view <http://www.htmlhelp.com/reference/wilbur/head/meta.html>

Note : If you do not want the TITLE tag to appear as <h1> </h1> title at the start of each page, leave the title option blank and include your own TITLE tag within the additional header tag.

The **Page Top HTML** is the html which appears right above the thumbnail gallery table. This can include banner tags or description of the thumbnail galleries.

The **Page Bottom HTML** is the html which appears right below the thumbnail gallery table. This can include banner tags or copyright tags.

Additional Checkboxes

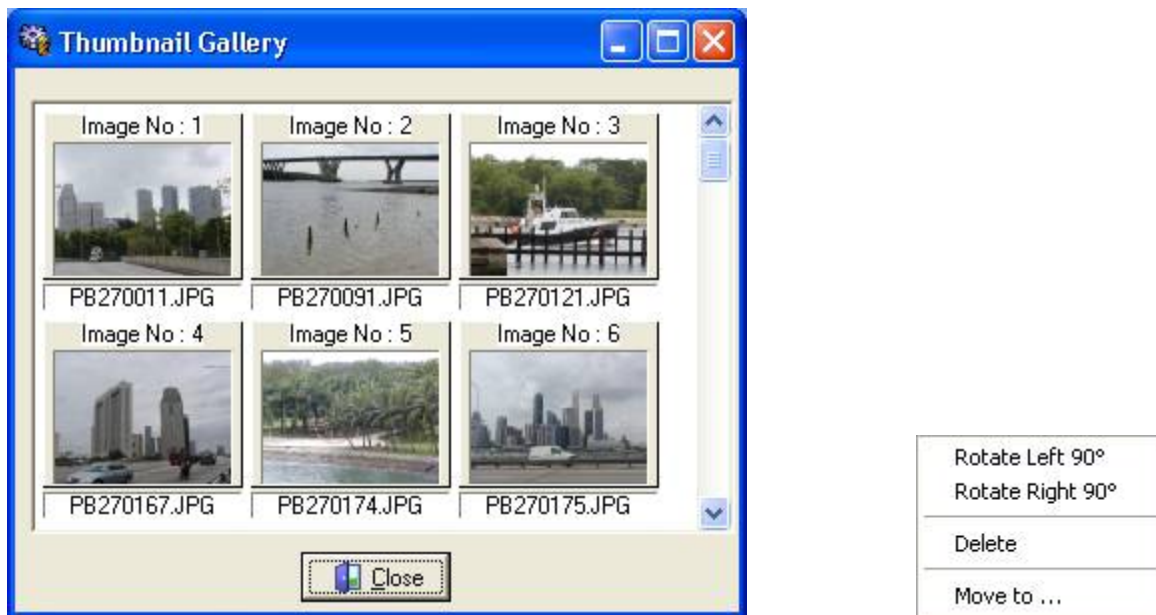
Include Additional Heading in Image HTML - if this is checked, it will include the same header in all pages generated by Web It!

Include Page Top HTML in Image HTML - if this is checked, it will include all page top html in all pages generated by Web It!

Include Page Bottom HTML in Image HTML - if this is checked, it will include all page bottom html in all pages generated by Web It!

8.4 Thumbnail Gallery Preview

Thumbnail Gallery Preview



The Thumbnail Gallery preview allows you to **Rotate, Delete or Move** the images within the loaded list.

Once you select the image you want to work on click on the right-most button of the mouse to bring up the Popup Menu, this will bring up the popup menu.

Rotating Images

When you **rotate** the images, it would save the changes to the original image file. The rotate function only works with JPEG images for now.

Deleting Images

The **delete** function allows you to remove any images from the list. The actual image file would not be tampered with. Any deleted files would not be processed. The change would be reflected on the file listing.

Move to ...

The **move to** function allows you to change the order of the image within the gallery. When you click on the Move to function, you would be prompted with a dialog box. Enter the new image number. The change would be reflected on the file listing.

For example, if you want to move Image 12 to the position of Image 2, enter 2 in the box. The Image Number would reflect the new order after the change.

9 How to

9.1 Load Image Files

Load Image Files

Web It! provides 3 ways of loading image files into the program. It currently support JPEG, GIF and PNG images as these are the most commonly acceptable images for web use.

Using Load Files

If you want to load files selectively, use the Load Files method.

Note : Windows does not officially keep the selected sort order. On some systems such as Windows NT and Windows 2000, selecting the first file first and the last file last would retain the sort order. On other system, you would need to select the last file first and the first file last to maintain the sort order. This is beyond the control of our program and is related to the way windows work.

Using Load Folder

Using Load Folder if you want to load the entire folder of images wholesale. The sort order is maintain.

Using Drag n Drop

You can drag the file name lists from Windows Explorer and drop it into Web It!. It will import all valid files into the file list.

9.2 Manipulating the image files in the Control Center

Change the Sort Order of the Images

Web It! allows you to change the sort order of the images. There are times when the order may not match the order you want.

Select the row of the image or images you want to move. This should highlight those rows. Click on the row bar, this should change to a select arrow. Hold down the rows and move it to where you want to place them in.

Deleting Images

Select the row of the image or images you want to delete. This should highlight the rows. Click the Right-most mouse butto

9.3 Create Web Thumbnail Galleries

Creating Web Thumbnail Galleries

Web It! allows you to create HTML galleries and the galleries created can be used on the internet without modification. It can be deployed to any Windows, Linux or Mac web hosting server.

The program will create all the HTML pages in the directory you specify in the Save In Directory. All thumbnails created would be save in the sub-folder /thumbnails . What you would need to do is to transfer all the files including this sub-folder to your website and should be able to view them

immediately.

There are several ways of transferring the files to your web site. The typical method would be FTP transfer or via the web page. For more information, please refer to your web site.

By default, the first file would be name index1.html .

So on your web-browser, enter <http://yourwebsiteaddress/index1.html> and it will show the first thumbnail galleries page.

Note : Substitute the yourwebsiteaddress with the actual web address of your server.

There is a comprehensive links of man of the web servers which allows you to host for free in exchange for some banners on their pages. Do check with their terms and conditions for the type of files which they accept. We are not related to any of the services on that page.

9.4 Create AutoRun CD Album

Creating AutoRun CD Album

Web It! creates HTML Thumbnail Galleries and uses pure HTML codes. There are no proprietary codes in the source files so you could easily view them on any computer with a web browser.

Although the program does not burn CD-ROM or CD-RW but if you have a CD or DVD writer, you would already have the necessary program to do the CD writing.

If you want to create an Auto-RUN CD-Album, you will to check the **Create Autorun.inf** on the HTML Wizard page under the Save In column. This will create the necessary file which would point to the first index page.

Just copy all the files in the thumbnail galleries page and all sub-folders to the CD-ROM template. The created CD-ROM would launch the first index page when it is inserted to a Windows based computer.

Creating your own Autorun.inf file

If however, you want to create your own Autorun.inf file, it is relative simple to do. All you need is a text editor such as Notepad or Wordpad.

Include the following in the editor

Under Windows 95/98

```
[autorun]
open=index1.html
```

Under Windows NT/XP/2000

```
[autorun]
shellexecute=index1.html
```

and save it as **autorun.inf** . Make sure it is on the main directory on the CD-ROM when you write it to CD. The next time you insert the CD-ROM into a Windows based computer which supports autorun CD, it will launch the main index page.

There is an cross-Microsoft-Windows incompatibility issue with the way autorun files are to be run. As such, since v2.22 we have included a basic HTML Viewer (bhtmlviewer.exe) which would work under all Windows platform (starting from Windows 95).

The Autorun.inf contains the following :-

```
[autorun]  
open=bhtmlviewer.exe "index1.html"
```

You can substitute index1.html for any other files which you want to autorun.
